- 1. A member in good standing with USA Judo, USJA, USJF, or ATJA for USA competitors. A member of their national federation for international players. A copy of your current membership card will be required at registration.
- 2. At least 30 years of age. Year of birth must be 1993 or earlier. Proof of age consisting of birth certificate, passport, or current USA Judo membership card having the age verification symbol "V" printed following the date of birth. Note: A Driver's

License is not acceptable as proof of age.

The Tournament Directors reserve the right to make any changes that are in the best interest of the contestants to achieve fairness and competition.

Match Times: All Divisions (All Ranks):

Under 60 years old 3 minutes match time and unlimited golden score 60 years old and older 2.5 minutes match time and 1 minute golden score

Judo Gi's: Contestants are encouraged to bring 2 gis (1 blue & 1

White). First called contestant must wear white gi. Second called is encouraged to wear a blue gi, but a white gi with blue belt will be allowed. One contestant MUST have a white Judo Gi - No matches where both contestants have a

blue Judo Gi.
